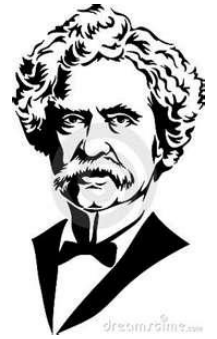


# Meet Mark Twain! Field Trip Permission Form
